Admission / 2.860,00€

Paid on student's admission to the school. There is a 50% discount for siblings.

Non refundable fee.

Matriculation Fee / 686,00€

Annual payment. Paid on confirmation of the pupil's place for the following school year. Includes school material, books and school insurance. Paid in February or March.

Fees

10 monthly payments. There is a 20% discount for the second sibling, always applied to the youngest. 3% discount on annual tuition is available if paid in full before the 15th of June.



Fees includes

- Tuition including teaching, tutoring and counselling, and additional language and special educational needs support as needed and within the limits defined in the BCA Admissions Policy and BCA Inclusion Policy.
- Educational resources and materials, individual stationery, online resources and textbooks.
- Daily lunch and snack/s (opt out is not available).
- Insurance for pupils whilst engaged in school activities. Includes civil liability and accident insurance.

Annual Payment

Additional charges are made for the following, which are not included in the Annual Fee:

- School Uniform, purchased directly from the supplier.
- After-School Activities.
- Educational off-site visits.
- The school ski programme.
- Use of the school bus service.
- (Year 10 and above) Provision of a personal computer (laptop/Chromebook) Pupils need to have a device to use in their lessons and their assignments. They will use this device all through KS4 and IBDP. The school offers the possibility to buy them at school.
- External (public) examinations and tests, such as IGCSE and IB Diploma Examinations, and external standardised tests (such as the CAT4 cognitive assessment). This charge includes both the fee charged by the examination board or testing agency and the handling and costs of the secure courier service used to send the examination scripts.
- Additional EAL or SEN tuition. BCA's English as an Additional Language (EAL) support and Special Educational Needs (SEN) provision is sufficient to provide most pupils with good access to the curriculum. Where a pupil's needs are greater and cannot be met by the usual provision, BCA will make a charge for additional tuition. The fee and arrangements will be discussed and agreed upon during the admissions process or, for continuing pupils, during the re-enrolment process. The BCA Admissions Policy will be followed.
- Yearbook, if provided.



Penalties for Unpaid Fees

- A 5% surcharge is applied to returned or late direct debits for fees.
- All collection charges for unpaid fees are charged to parents.
- Failure to pay fees may result in withholding certificates, reports, services, or, subject to ensuring alternative educational local provision for the pupil, exclusion from school.

Written notice Three months' written notice is required for withdrawal of a pupil (one term ahead); otherwise, three months' fees are payable. Fees remain due during the notice period.

Conditions

- As a general rule, fees are non-refundable, but in exceptional cases, justified situations (serious illness, relocation, etc.) may be considered.
- To hold a place during a period of education elsewhere, the school has the right to charge a proportion of school fees.
- School fees are reviewed annually and are subject to change.
- The school reserves the right to cancel a pupil's placement for the following academic year if fees remain outstanding.
- In the event of *a force majeure* closure, priority will be given to maintaining the service through alternative means, or otherwise, proportional adjustments may be applied.
