The British College of Andorra is pleased to announce the IB Ambassador leadership program for DP students. These leaders will tutor students in KS2–KS4 on ATL skills and mentor through IB Learner Profile values, they will host weekly global issue forums, and produce multimedia school news reports, in addition to collaborating with House Captains to embed IB values into school life.

To apply, students must submit a Digital Vision Board. To ensure selection is based on vision rather than popularity, boards must not include the student's name or photo.



- **Role Benefits:** Greatly strengthens university applications, fulfills all CAS requirements, and builds professional leadership skills.
- **Deadline:** Digital submissions are due immediately upon return from the Easter holiday. (13/4/26)
- **Selection:** The secondary student body and staff will vote on the anonymous proposals to select the new ambassadors.

The Owls created a game to play with the Peacocks in order to show their posters. The results go beyond the displays-it is the relationships of cooperation and teamwork that truly matter.




ROBINS' WRITING

The activity brought together several key elements of business and collaboration, including design, communication, teamwork, and strategic thinking.

Working within their Houses, students took on different roles as they developed their ideas. Teams designed their PE kits, built their company identity, and carefully considered how to present their product. The project culminated with our Year 10 Business students delivering persuasive pitches on behalf of their teams, presenting their proposals and explaining why their company should be chosen as the supplier.
